



REGULATIONS

Access to the camp site is only allowed for persons holding a valid and recognized certificate.

On arrival, contact the camp manager immediately for registration and pitch allocation.

Fire Regulations dictate that distance between camping units must be at least 3 meters.

When installing wind/sun-awnings using string these must be taken down at sunset.

It is not allowed to fence or change appearance of the pitches.

Dogs must be registered on arrival. We welcome all dogs, with the exception of fighting dogs (pit-bulls and the like) when you stay with us.

Cats and other pets are permitted on the site with prior permission.

Dog rules:

- The dog
- may not be noisy or otherwise be disturbing
 - Must always be on a leash
 - is not allowed in the common room or the sanitary buildings
 - Must swim to the right/north of the jetty
 - Must swim to the left/south of the jetty
 - may not use the path leading down to the fjord (please use the path at the south end of the campsite going through the forest)
 - is not allowed on the pier
 - must be walked outside of the campsite area (and remember that the forest, the beach as well as Solbyen also are considered our area).



Should your dog be so unlucky as to drop 'a little something' on the campsite area, please remove all traces immediately.

Poop-bags can be found at the gate opposite the information, as well as on the path leading through the forest.

Upon departure accounts must be settled with the camp manager no later than 11:00 a.m. on the day of departure.

The association assumes no responsibility for effects that are left on the site.

Driving on the camp site is permitted only when placing the caravan or mobile home. Cars must be parked in the parking lot. **Mind the children - drive carefully.**

Nudity is required – weather permitting. Bikinis and swimming trunks etc. are not allowed. The rules apply to both adults and children.

Photography/filming may take place only with the explicit consent of each of those being photographed or filmed. If there is any doubt as to whether or not consent has been given, the camera must be handed over to the camp manager for viewing.

No noise between 23:00 and 08:00. On Friday's and Saturday's between 24:00 and 08:00.

Annoying, provocative and indecent behavior is not allowed.

Because of fire hazard, smoking and open flames are not allowed in the plantation.

The gate is closed between the hours 22:00, pm 08:00

If you intend to leave/return during this period, please contact the camp manager during office hours for a key or park your car in the parking lot at Sydmarksvej (about 100 meters away)

The camp manager is authorized to expel any person not complying with these regulations. The Board takes final decisions in any disputes.
